

TRAIL INFORMATION

Please use caution: Trails are unpaved and may have exposed roots, stumps or uneven ground. Trails pass through upland hardwood forest and successional hardwood forest requiring ongoing removal of invasive plant infestations.

Stay on designated trails to avoid trespassing. Always take precautions to deter biting and stinging insects and respectfully observe wildlife from a safe distance. Hikers and bikers share the trail - use courtesy when interacting with other trail users.

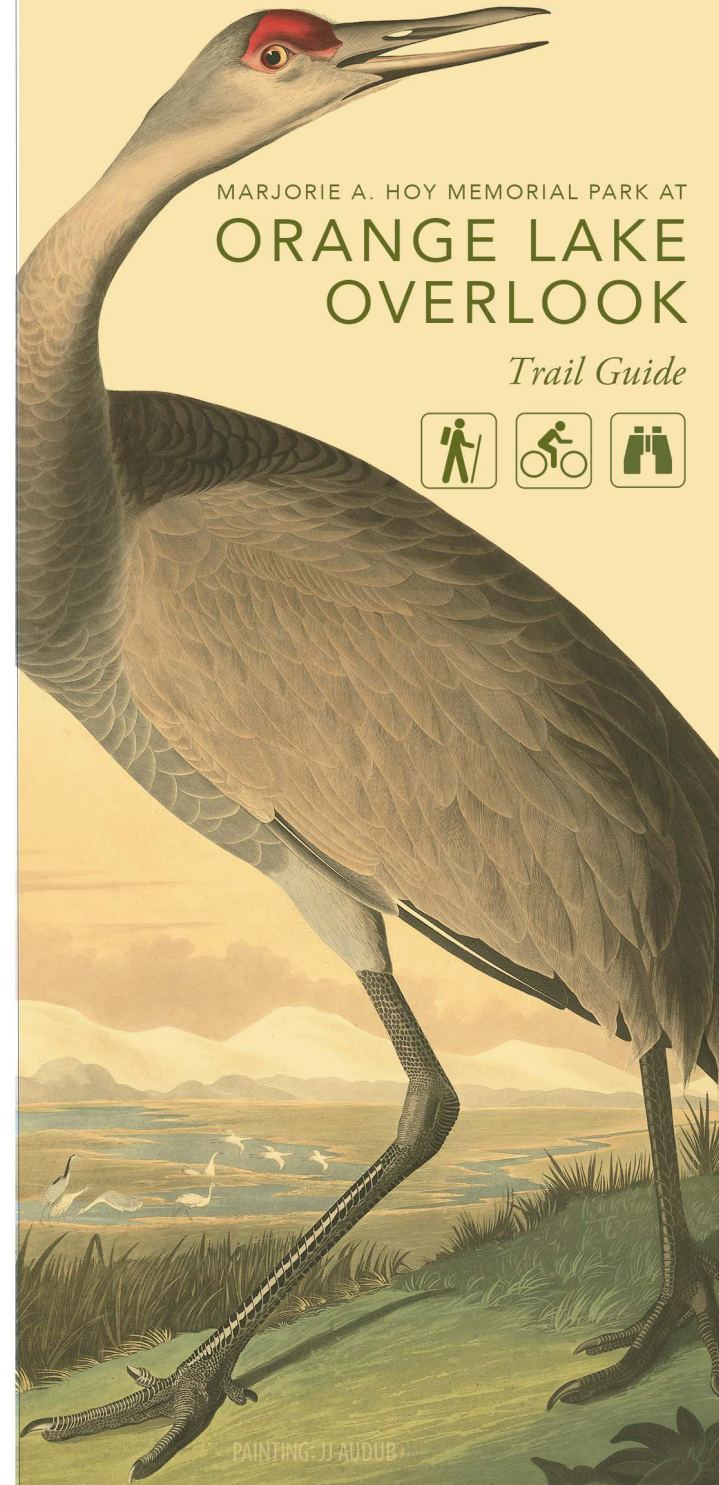

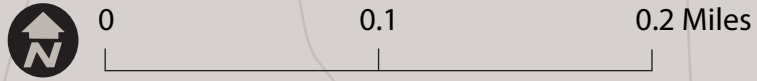
